



COVID REMINDERS

- If your child has a potential exposure to a COVID positive staff member – you will be notified and asked to seek medical guidance – advice from your child’s treating physician on what to do next, if anything
- If your child has a potential exposure to a COVID positive family member- please notify Angie Lanoux immediately. You will be asked to see medical guidance.
- If your child has symptoms *of any illness or tests positive for COVID*, please notify Angie Lanoux immediately. A written medical clearance from your child’s treating physician will be required to return to services.
- If your child develops *any symptoms of illness* while in center, you will be notified and asked to pick up your child as soon as possible, preferably within 30 minutes. A written medical clearance from your child’s treating physician will be required or your child must be symptom free to return to services.

Medical Guidance – advice from a physician on what course of action, if any, should happen

Medical Clearance – a written note from a physician stating that a child is medically cleared to return to services
